

Registered Landscape Architect

Under direction, primary duties include performing advanced professional landscape architecture work relating to mostly construction oversight of Municipal and ADOT projects. This position also performs regular field inspections for erosion control and reviews Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plans (SWPPP) for compliance and updates of projects statewide.

Other duties include review of landscape plant and irrigation submittals to ensure compliance with quality expectations, plans and specifications; pre-approval of plant material at local nurseries; review quantities for periodic contractor pay requests; and pursue new work with government clients throughout the State of Arizona. Anticipated to be 10%-20% utilization, this position may also prepare renderings, cost estimates, construction drawings and other minor design work depending on individual qualifications. Work requires application of landscape architecture and civil engineering technical principles.
