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## Entry guidelines

- Must complete entry and release form.
- Project submittal – digital submittal showing your PARKing day project; can include plans, sections, elevations, digital renderings, etc. to help explain your project. Provide one of the following per PARKing day installation project. Max size 10MB, email to coordinate submissions larger than 10MB.
- University Chapters: Submit a 24x36 digital PDF
- High Schools: Submit an 8.5x11 digital PowerPoint, 10 page max, or 24x36 digital PDF
- Written letter of consent or proof of funding
- University Chapters: Proof of funding identifying where matching funds were received
- High Schools: Letter of consent from school administration providing consent and cooperation of installation location on campus. Students must also ask permission to reinstall projects at the State Capitol in April 2018.
- Winning entries must photograph their installations day of, and tag #AZASLA, @AZ\_ASLA, @landscapearch, and #ASLAPD2017 on Instagram and Facebook.

## Rules

- Entries due September 11, 2017, and will be reviewed by AZASLA's PARKing Day Committee and winners will be announced by no later than September 13th, 2017.
- All entry materials will become property of AZASLA, and reserves the right to post information on social media sites.
- Locally registered ASLA University level student chapters can receive up to \$250 match grants for PARKing day. Student Chapters must fundraise and provide financial backing that they have acquired an amount of up to \$250 dedicated to PARKing day.
- Winning projects must be installed on PARKing day on September 15th, 2017, and remain on identified site for most of the day.
- Winning teams/students will receive ASLA shirts and buttons complementary national ASLA.
- All entries are suggested to enter into national ASLA's PARKing day competition by posting photos on Instagram and tagging #ASLAPD2017.
- All entries are suggested to send photos to AZASLA of actual parking day installations for digital publication.
- Winning entries must commit to salvaging, storing, and reinstalling PARKing day projects for AZASLA's Advocacy Day at the State Capitol in April 2018. Exact date TBD.
- ASLA University level student chapter must have their installations located off-campus in a highly visible area to increase Public Awareness of Landscape Architecture and AZASLA. Parking locations must be procured legally and with the parking owner's consent.
- Winning entries must also find personal means to transport projects, install, and uninstall projects at State Capitol.
- All installations at the State Capitol will be insured by national ASLA on Advocacy Day.
- All installations must be designed and built with the primary concern being safety of both the student participants and the general public.
