### Irrigation Designer

ABLA is now hiring to fill an Irrigation Designer position. This is a full-time entry-level position and the ideal candidate should meet the following requirements:

#### Standard Requirements:

- Provides irrigation design support with oversight from Senior Staff, Senior Irrigation Managers, and Irrigation Managers and other staff through preliminary design, routing, sizing, and irrigation construction documents, specifications, and cost estimates pertaining to the development of firm arranged projects;
- Develops irrigation documents that provide the client with an understanding of the proposed water sourcing, routing, distribution, pumping, and management including: plans, analysis studies (topographic, climatic, land use, vegetation, pumping, etc.);

- o Performs the development of irrigation documents and permit applications required for local, state, county approval;
- o Utilizes accurate scaling, proportions and interpretation of layouts, sketches, redlined prints, or other drawings;
- o Utilizes CAD and design software to create construction details, design document, and construction documents;
- o Produces rough designs and sketches for CAD development to construction documents;
- o Creates highly detailed documents (plans, sections, details, material schedules) ready for landscape construction companies to provide an initial pricing (tender) on the project;
- o Interprets and inputs the conceptual designs, sets up construction documents, and formats sheet sets in CAD to provide the framework for the construction document sets;
- o Reviews and sets up drawings & designs to ensure adherence to municipality and in-house specifications & standards;
- o Reviews all work for completeness and accuracy prior to submitting for review;
- Maintains and updates irrigation material schedules necessary for the completion of the projects;

Special Requirements:
